



PROPOSED ITINERARY

Day 1: Depart in the morning for Boston, Massachusetts. Arrive in the afternoon and visit the **New England Aquarium** followed by dinner and exploring Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market.

Day 2: Visit **Lexington and Concord**, where the first shots of the Revolution were fired. Walk the Lexington Green, see the **Old North Bridge Battle** site, and visit the Museum of Our National Heritage. Return to Boston after lunch for a full city tour along the **Freedom Trail** including the U.S.S. Constitution, Little Italy, **Paul Revere's House** (exterior), and a special educational program at the **Old North Church**.

Day 3: Depart in the morning for Plymouth MA and the **Plimoth Plantation**. See Plymouth as it was in 1700! Tour the village and climb aboard the **Mayflower II**, a replica of the original.

Depart after lunch for **New York City**. We want you to experience Manhattan at its best, so we have arranged for you to stay right in the heart of the city! Dinner followed by evening walking tour of Midtown which will include **Times Square**, MTV Studios, Rockefeller Center, St. Patrick's Cathedral, NBC Studios and **Empire State Building**.

Day 4: Morning cruise past the **Statue of Liberty** and a visit to **Ellis Island** to learn about the waves of immigrants that came ashore from 1892-1924.

Once back on shore visit the **World Trade Center Site** and other offerings in this area including a visit to historic Trinity Church and **Federal Hall** (where George Washington gave his first Inaugural Address) as well as sites in the Financial District including **Wall Street** and the New York Stock Exchange. Possible trip to South Street Seaport, preserving New York's historic seafaring tradition and to see the Brooklyn Bridge. **Broadway Show** in the evening!

Day 5: Morning visit to **Central Park!** Following a stroll through the park experience the best of shopping in the Big Apple on 5th Avenue and at the Macy's Department Store before departing for Pennsylvania and the **Amish Country!**

Our group will experience the Amish lifestyle at a country inn with a **buggy ride**, traditional costumes, cooking lesson, farm activities, story-telling, Dutch meals, and homemade ice cream and popcorn!

Day 6: Finish our Amish experience after lunch and depart for **Philadelphia** in the afternoon. Evening performance and walking tour.

Day 7: Independence Park area – Visitor's Center, **Independence Hall**, **Liberty Bell Constitution Center**, Franklin Court, Betsy Ross House, Elfreth Alley. Depart for home!
